Consultation on the Development of Pan-European Access to Financial Information Disclosed by Listed Companies

Some years ago I was involved in an informal working group in London, which was addressing the inconsistencies actually found in disseminated Financial Information.

We identified that different wholesalers / distributors were making different assumptions / interpretations re: the disclosure source documentation, thus leading to inconsistencies in the information eventually reaching participants / individuals via multiple sources.

We concluded that, if Financial Information Disclosures could be standardised onto XBRL-enabled templates, this could eliminate the different assumptions / interpretations. Moreover, a representative of Adobe Systems held that it is perfectly possible to XBRL-enable any template configured in Adobe Acrobat – thereby producing consistent printed <u>and</u> machine-readable outputs.

Our working group saw this as an ideal solution, considering that there would be an 'almost zero' implementation cost for the Listed Companies themselves (and on the basis that any significant costs would be an obstacle).
