

Dániel Csányi was appointed as the Executive Director of the Central Bank of Hungary (MNB – Magyar Nemzeti Bank) in June 2025 responsible for the supervision of Capital, Insurance and Pension Fund Markets. Before his appointment he used to work at the Magyar Fejlesztési Bank – MFB (Hungarian Development Bank) as Chief Financial Officer. During his nearly eight years at MFB he held several professional and leadership positions, including Director of Strategic and Group Management Directorate and Head of Strategy Department.

He is currently responsible for managing the Prudential Supervision of Intermediaries Independent Department, the Insurance and Pension Funds Supervision Directorate and the Capital Markets and Market Supervision Directorate. Within this duties he is responsible for the prudential supervision of investment firms and investment funds in Hungary, he is also in charge of market surveillance procedures to prevent capital market abuse and oversees the compliance of public listed companies with market transparency requirements. Dániel Csányi is also responsible for the prudential supervision of insurance undertakings and pension funds, including on-site and offsite activities, quarterly risk assessments, regular comprehensive inspections and for the prudential supervision of financial market intermediaries, insurance intermediaries and tied agents in the capital market ensuring the compliance with legal regulations through inspections and continuous supervision of the supervised institutions.
