



# Jimmy Kvarnström

## *Biographical Profile*

Jimmy Kvarnström is Executive Director, Markets, at the Swedish Financial Supervisory Authority (Finansinspektionen), where he leads the supervision and development of Sweden's securities and capital markets, including trading venues, market infrastructures, market conduct, transparency and investment firms. He is a member of FI's executive management team.

Prior to joining FI in 2025, Mr Kvarnström served as Chief Legal Officer and Head of Market Surveillance at Nordic Growth Market (NGM), where he was responsible for listing, trading, issuer supervision and market abuse controls.

He has extensive experience from Nasdaq, where he held senior legal and regulatory roles over more than a decade (2006–2023), including as Deputy General Counsel and Head of Market Surveillance for Nasdaq's European operations. In these roles, he led regulatory and surveillance teams across multiple jurisdictions and was closely involved in the implementation of key EU regulatory frameworks, including MiFID II, EMIR, CSDR and GDPR.

Mr Kvarnström has also held positions at Swedbank, where he headed the legal function for sustainability, governance and conduct, and at the law firm Vinge.

He is a board member of the Stockholm Center for Commercial Law Research Panel and has previously served on the board of the Swedish Corporate Governance Institute.

He holds an Executive MBA from the Stockholm School of Economics and a Master of Laws (LL.M.) from Lund University.
