Giovanni Petrella is a Professor of Banking at Università Cattolica in Milano, where he teaches derivative securities and market microstructure.

He holds a Ph.D. in Financial Markets from Università Cattolica and an M.A. in Economics from Bocconi University.



He is currently serving as the Director of the graduate program in Banking and Finance and as a member of the board of the Department of Management at Università Cattolica.

He is a member of the Securities and Markets Stakeholder Group at the European Securities and Markets Authority (ESMA) since 2016.

He was a member of the Consultative Working Group for the Secondary Markets Standing Committee at ESMA from 2012 to 2014.

He was a member of the Banking Stakeholder Group at the European Banking Authority (EBA) in London from 2016 to 2018.

He is a regular speaker at supervisory authorities' meetings, academic seminars, and conferences.

His research interests are in the areas of market microstructure, derivatives, and portfolio management. He has published three books and various articles in scholarly journals. He acts as a referee for the Italian Ministry of University and Research, CONSOB (Italian Authority on Securities and Markets), and several academic journals in the fields of finance and banking.
