




List of competent authorities designated as single contact points by EU Member States for purposes of Article 79 of the Directive 2014/65/EU on Markets in Financial Instruments (MiFID II)

ESMA is an independent EU Authority that contributes to safeguarding the stability of the European Union's financial system by enhancing the protection of investors and promoting stable and orderly financial markets.

According to Article 79(1) of MiFID II, "In order to facilitate and accelerate cooperation, and more particularly exchange of information, Member States shall designate a single competent authority as a contact point for the purposes of this Directive and of Regulation (EU) No 600/2014. Member States shall communicate to the Commission, ESMA and to the other Member States the names of the authorities which are designated to receive requests for exchange of information or cooperation pursuant to this paragraph. ESMA shall publish and keep up-to-date a list of those authorities on its website".

The list below compiles the information required under Article 79(1) of MiFID II. This list will be updated as necessary following any changes to this information notified by national competent authorities to ESMA.

The publication of the information on this list does not prejudice the results of verifications on the completeness and correctness of the transposition of EU law into national law.
