Marina Brogi is Full Professor and Deputy Dean at the Faculty of Economics, La Sapienza University, Rome (Italy) where she has been involved in teaching and research as of 1998. From 1988 she worked at Bocconi University, Milan, first as research fellow and as of 1993 as researcher.

Her main research interests are Capital markets, corporate governance of listed companies and bank management. She has published numerous books and articles and is member of the Scientific Committee for the Consob-Bocconi conferences and of the Scientific Committee for the preparation of the Annual Report on the State of the Italian Financial System of the Rosselli Foundation.

Complementary to her academic experience Prof. Brogi serves as independent non-executive director on the Boards of listed and unlisted companies and has been appointed by the Bank of Italy in the governance bodies in the liquidation of banks and other intermediaries subject to supervision. She currently serves on the boards of A2A, Impregilo, Prelios and UBI Banca and chairs the Remuneration and Nominating Committee of Impregilo and is the Deputy Chair of the Remuneration Committee of A2A. She also chairs the Supervisory Committee of Credito Cooperativo Fiorentino in compulsory administrative liquidation and the Supervisory Committee of Cape Natixis SGR in compulsory administrative liquidation.

She was appointed by the Labour Minister in the Work group for monitoring the implementation of law 120/2012 in state-controlled companies and has been invited to present her Expert opinion to public hearings of the Labour Commission of the Italian Senate and the Finance Commission of the Italian Camera (Italy's lower house).

She holds a Degree in Economics from Bocconi University and took part in the MBA at London Business School via the 1988 International Exchange Programme.

In December 2013, she was appointed by the European Securities and Markets Authority (ESMA) in the Securities and Markets Stakeholder Group.
