Dr Christopher P. Buttigieg is the Director of the Securities and Markets Supervision Unit of the Malta Financial Services Authority. He joined the Authority in 2000 as a manager in the Investment Services Unit and has gained professional experience in different areas of financial supervision and the investigation and enforcement of market misconduct and malpractice. He sits on the Authority's Supervisory Council and has represented the MFSA at various European Fora on financial regulation and supervision.

Dr Buttigieg has a Bachelor of Accountancy (Hons.) and an M.A. in Financial Services from the University of Malta, and an M.A. in European Law and Society and a D.Phil. in Law Studies from the University of Sussex (UK). His Doctoral thesis deals with the governance of EU securities regulation and supervision. Dr Buttigieg is a lecturer in the Banking and Finance Department of the University of Malta and has published various articles in academic and professional journals which focus on EU law and on regulation and supervision in general.

Dr Buttigieg is a director on the board of the Malta Resources Authority. In 2015 the President of Malta appointed Dr Buttigieg as a member on the board of the Fund for Voluntary Organisations.
