

Michael Nietsch holds the Chair for Private Law, Company Law and Securities Regulation at EBS Law School in Wiesbaden, Germany. Previously he was Associate Professor at Johannes Gutenberg-University of Mainz (Centre for German and International Laws of Financial Services). Michael also is director of the Centre for Corporate Compliance at EBS Law School. His research and publications deal with

topics of German and international corporate law giving emphasis to requirements of legal compliance and liability of companies and their directors and officers. He also works extensively in the field of banking- and financial regulation. Main fields of interest are the prevention of market abuse, in particular insider dealing and consumer finance contracts. Further attention is given to issues arising under the term of sustainable finance. Michael is a frequent rapporteur to congresses and has taught nationally and internationally.
