Work experience

Rafał Mikusiński has been actively involved in the Polish capital market since its inception in 1991.

He started his professional activity at the Bank Pekao brokerage (subsidiary of Unicredit SpA). He participated in the formation of the Brokerage House of the American Bank in Poland, where he worked between 1994 and 1996 as Investment Specialist. Then, between 1997 and 1999, he managed insurance portfolios of AGF Insurance Unit in Poland.

In 1999, Rafał Mikusiński started his work at Amplico (subsidiary of AIG, company managing 2nd pillar pension fund) in the Investment Department, where he was responsible for debt instrument portfolio management, basic economic analysis, and fund liquidity management. In 2004, he took over the duties of Director of the Investment Department, and in March 2008 he was appointed as the Management Board member responsible for the fund's investment policy. From November 2010, he acted as President of the Management Board.

In 2014, Rafał Mikusiński was appointed as member of the Management Board of MetLife TUnŻiR (life insurance company), and as Director for Investments he was responsible for the group's investments in Poland. In the same year, he was appointed to act in the Supervisory Boards of MetLife Investment Fund Management and Pension Fund Management in Poland. At the same time, between 2015 and 2017, he acted as Eastern and Southern Europe Investment Head. From December 2017, he also supervised the activities of investment and pension funds in the EMEA region.

Since March 2019, he has held the position of Deputy Chair of the KNF Board responsible for capital markets supervision (primary and secondary market, investment companies, UCITS and Fund management).

Education

He graduated from the Faculty of Organisation and Management of the University of Warsaw.
