Rüdiger Veil

Professor Dr. Rüdiger Veil holds the chair for civil law and business law at the Ludwig-Maximilians-University (LMU), Munich/Germany, and is director at the Munich Center for Capital Markets Law (MuCCML) at LMU. He graduated at the Humboldt University, Berlin in 1995 with a doctoral thesis on 'Conversion of a Stock Corporation'. In 2002, he obtained his habilitation at the Humboldt University with a book on 'Inter-company Agreements'. Rüdiger has published books on 'European Capital Markets Law' (3^{rd.} edition 2022, Hart Publishing) and on 'The Law of Corporations' (6^{th.} edition 2015, Beck). His more than 100 articles in top ranked journals and research handbooks deal with all areas of EU securities regulation from a comparative and interdisciplinary perspective.

Rüdiger was a member of the ESMA Securities and Markets Stakeholder Group (SMSG) from 2014 to 2018; from 2016 to 2018, he was Chair of the SMSG. Since 2012, Rüdiger has been advising the German Federal Ministry of Finance with a special focus on reforms of EU financial markets regulation. He has acted as an expert for the German, European, Chinese and Russian parliament on draft laws on corporate law and capital markets law. In 2015, Rüdiger submitted the 'Report on Access to Capital Markets for Emerging Growth Companies' to the German Federal Ministry for Economic Affairs and Energy and in 2017 the 'Report on Sustainable Investments through Financial Market Regulation' to the German Federal Ministry for the Environment.
