Results of CESR's call for evidence on the second mandate on possible implementing measures of the future Market Abuse Directive

On 7 February 2003, the European Commission published its second mandate to CESR for advice on technical implementing measures under the Directive on Insider Dealing and Market Manipulation (Market Abuse). On the same day, CESR published a call for evidence to all interested parties, inviting them to submit views on the areas which CESR should address in its advice to the European Commission (Ref.: CESR/03-037). The deadline for the submission of contributions was 28 February 2003.

CESR received directly 20 responses and these are being released today. They have been categorised by sector and include responses from European trade associations, national trade associations and individual respondents. Please click on the hyperlink to access the relevant response.
